## **Upcoming Member Tournaments to put on your schedule:**

### **Match Play Championship - Qualifying extended to May 31st**

Anybody interested in participating, please specify with the golf shop staff you want your round to count for qualifying. Please have someone attest scorecard and round and return card to golf shop with tees played. Entry Fee for Match Play is \$40 per player. Please pay entry fee on the day of qualifying round.

### **2-Day Member/Member - June 1st and 2nd**

Accepting teams/pairings in the golf shop now. Entry Fee is **\$80 per team plus \$20 cart fee for those members who do not have annual plan or trail fee**. Saturday will be a 9am, 11:30am and 2pm shotgun playing 27 holes in 9 hole matches against 3 teams in your flight. Sunday will be 9am and 1:30pm shotgun playing 18 holes in 9-hole matches against final teams in your flight. Food will be provided on Saturday in a box lunch and available after the second 9-hole match and as a buffet upon completion of Sunday's final match.

### **Men's Member/Guest - June 20th-23rd**

Take advantage of the **\$525** per team early bird registration and get signed up in the golf shop prior to **May 30th**. After **May 31st** entry fees rise to **\$600** per team. To get a preferred tee time for Friday play payment must accompany registration. Forms are located in the golf shop now and will be available online shortly.
